Citi Readies for 9th Global Community Day Around 3,000 volunteers to join 7 NGOs in 23 community activities in Hong Kong

HONG KONG – The ninth Citi Global Community Day (GCD), the bank's annual pinnacle event of giving back to the community through volunteering, will be held on June 7, 2014. At the kick-off ceremony today with senior representatives from collaborating community partners, Weber Lo, Citi Country Officer and CEO, Hong Kong & Macau said, "The Citi Global Community Day has become very much a part of the Citibanker experience where we fulfill a shared commitment to dedicate time and expertise to serving local communities. Citi Hong Kong prides itself on being an active leader in our community, and GCD is a great way to remind ourselves the importance of giving back to this place we call home."
