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Citi Volunteers in Hong Kong Commemorate Company's 200th Anniversary on Annual Global Community Day

HONG KONG – Citi highlighted its ongoing and long-standing commitment to helping communities by marking its 200th anniversary last Saturday, June 16, with its seventh annual Global Community Day.

Led by senior management from Asia Pacific and Hong Kong, Citi Hong Kong volunteers, comprising employees as well as their families, friends and corporate clients, engaged in nearly 40 community activities spanning charity fund-raising, care of the elderly, the physically challenged and underprivileged children, around the theme of *"One Bank, Two Centuries, Supporting Communities Together"*.

Shengman Zhang, Citi Country Officer for Citi Hong Kong, said, "We are very encouraged by the enthusiasm and passion of the Hong Kong employees and to see the number of participants in this signature event increases year by year. Volunteerism is a fundamental element of Citi's culture. Through our year-round community services, including the annual Global Community Day, we work collectively to strengthening local communities and making Hong Kong a better place."

Globally, Citi mobilized 100,000 volunteers in 92 countries around the world – the largest number of participants ever – in 1,300 service projects that will benefit local communities. Across Asia Pacific, more than 50,000 volunteers were engaged in 320 community events in 18 markets. This year, several new programs in Hong Kong were introduced, including the Citi GCD Cup and Dialogue in the Dark.

I am exceptionally proud that our Asia Pacific employees are once again at the forefront of our Global Community Day. We had over 50,000 volunteers across this region giving their time and effort to work in a number of creative ways with organizations and causes that we support, who carry out important and sometimes unheralded work in their communities.
