Citi Celebrates 20th Anniversary of Global Community Day Hong Kong employees surpass 159,000 volunteer hours

Hong Kong – Citi employees in Hong Kong collectively contributed over 159,000 hours to Global Community Day (GCD) volunteering activities in the past two decades. In celebration of the 20th anniversary of GCD this year, colleagues across the bank came together in support of a variety of local causes beyond year-round volunteering.

Working with community partners including Feeding Hong Kong, Hong Kong Red Cross, ImpactHK, PathFinders Hong Kong and Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, Citi staff volunteers spent time with elderly citizens, visited individuals with physical and mental disabilities, delivered food and necessities to the homeless and low-income families, and assembled maternity care packages for pregnant migrant domestic workers.

"For two decades, we have come together through volunteerism, showing up for those in need not only on Global Community Day, but all year round through our employee-led Citi Community Club," said Aveline San, CEO and Head of Banking for Citi Hong Kong. "The 20th anniversary of GCD is also a moment to reflect on the positive impact that Citi volunteers have made in collaboration with community organizations around the world. Through volunteerism and Citi Foundation's philanthropy, we strive to use our resources to help address social challenges and strengthen the communities where we live and work."

Since its inception in 2006, Global Community Day has become an annual tradition that brings together Citi employees globally to give back to the local communities. Through the years, staff volunteers across the organization have collectively completed over 1.2 million volunteer engagements in more than 80 countries and territories.
